ORDINANCE NO. 2001-1

Motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2001-1 by Robert Krause, second by Dave Marifilus.

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING AND DECLARING REASONABLE AND SAFE SPEED LIMITS ON THE TOWN ROADS OF THE TOWN OF NEW HAVEN.

WHEREAS. The Town Board is granted authority to modify speed limits on Town roads under Section 349.11 of Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, The Town Board has determined the speed limit set forth below to be reasonable and safe on the Town roads described herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NEW HAVEN, ADAMS COUNTY, WISCONSIN DOES HEREBY ORDIAN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: <u>Speed Limits Established</u>: The speed limits set forth below are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe speed limits, and said speed limits are hereby imposed and declared to be in effect on the following described town roads of the Town of New Haven:

- A. <u>Twenty-Five (25) Miles Per Hour</u>: On GOLDEN DRIVE, from FIRST LANE, east to the dead end, and on GOLDEN DRIVE, from FIRST LANE, west to the dead end.
- B. Thirty-Five (35) Miles Per Hour: On FIRST LANE from GOLDEN AVENUE to GOLDEN DRIVE.
- C. <u>Forty-Five (45) Miles Per Hour</u>: On all other town roads within the Town of New Haven

Section 2: Effective Date: The speed limit established by this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage of this ordinance, posting or publishing as required by law, and upon the appropriate signs giving notice of such speed limit having been erected and in place on the roads in question, as required by law.
