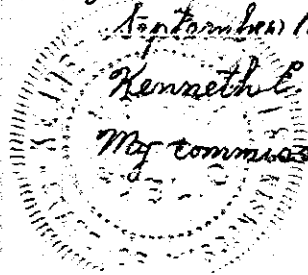

Upon application of 6 freeholders in the Town of New Haven for altering a highway, as set forth in the application to us, the undersigned, supervisors of the town, prepared a notice of the time and place we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on this 2nd day of October, 1992, at 10:00 in the forenoon at the town hall, that being the time and place stated in the notice; and having first been satisfied that the notices required in Wisconsin Statute 80.05 had been duly given and published, we did then examine the highway and did hear all reasons that were offered for the application. No one appeared in opposition to the proposed alteration. It being our opinion that

Now, therefore, pursuant to the application, we, the supervisors, do hereby order and determine that the highway be and the same is hereby altered as follows:

Beginning at the point where the 3 rod right of way ends at the East end of the Big Spring dam on Golden Ct in Sec 27 T14N, R7E thence West to the East boundary of Lot 10, New Haven assessors plat, in the unincorporated village of Big Spring, a distance of 431 feet more or less is henceforth also 3 rods in width. This includes all of that portion of the road which crosses the Big Spring dam.

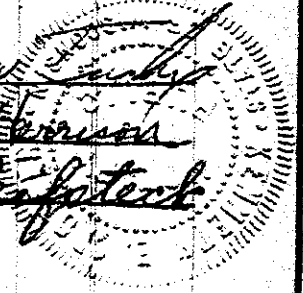
Release of Damages by David Tucker
