

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-3

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ALL TOWN ROADS WITHIN THE TOWN OF NEW HAVEN AS CLASS B HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the cost of constructing and maintaining a town road system is ever increasing; and

WHEREAS, most of the town roads within the Town of New Haven are not constructed to bear up under the traffic of heavy vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the classification of the town roads within the Town of New Haven as Class B highways will lower the use of such roads by heavy vehicles, thereby leading to less wear and deterioration of our town roads;

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NEW HAVEN, ADAMS COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: All Town Roads Designated as Class B Highways: All town roads within the Town of New Haven, Adams County, Wisconsin, are hereby designated as Class B highways. Such roads shall be subject to maximum weight limitations as specified in Sec. 348.16 Wis. Stats.

Section 2: Signs to be Posted: Appropriate signs shall be posted within the town giving notice of the fact that all roads within the town are Class B highways and subject to the weight limitations as specified herein. *weight limits: Single Axle, 10,000 and double axle 16,000.*

Section 3: Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force upon publication.
