A Resolution in Support of the Construction of a New High School

for the School District of Wisconsin Dells

WHEREAS, the School Board of the Wisconsin Dells School District unanimously approved the question to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$33,685,000 to construct and equip a new High School, and to convert the existing High School building into a Middle School serving grades sixth through eighth, and

WHEREAS, the School District of Wisconsin Dells has unanimously accepted the donation from Todd and Shari Nelson of 80 acres of land valued at \$3,200,000 located in the City of Wisconsin Dells for the purpose of building a new High School, and

WHEREAS, the School District of Wisconsin Dells has unanimously accepted a substantial gift of \$500,000 from Sally Olson Bracken, and


WHEREAS, the School District of Wisconsin Dells has unanimously accepted the Premier Resort Tax (PRT) investment in the amount of \$23,500,000 from the Village of Lake Delton and the City of Wisconsin Dells, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned contributions reduce the total cost to the taxpayers of the District by 45%,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of New Haven declares as follows:

The New Haven Town Board supports the School District of Wisconsin Dells November 6, 2018 Referendum to build a new High School and encourages its residents to vote "Yes" and support this needed construction.

Adopted this 20th of Sept, 2018 with a vote of 3 for and 0 against.
