

Town of New Haven, Adams County, Wisconsin

Minutes of August 17, 2023 Town Board Meeting

The August meeting of the New Haven Town Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Town Chairman Tory Wolfram.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the Clerk noted that proper notice had been given by posting, placing on the Town web site, and emails to those who have requested that form of notification.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with a motion by Supervisor Adam Watson and second by Supervisor Jason Musiedlak. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was presented and approved for filing with a motion by Jason, second by Adam. Motion carried.

There was no old business to consider and the only new business was a Variance Request by Dan and Karen Koenig to allow them to replace an older storage shed with a newer and slightly larger one. Due to limitations of lot size and location the building would need to be constructed with no setback from the west and south lot lines. The south lot line is an easement and in that easement are other neighboring structures which encroach on the easement. The new building proposed would not encroach. The west lot line is an unused and unimproved right of way to the shore of Lake Mason. This new building would not encroach on the right of way. The Board felt that the public good could be better served if the variance request were granted. Adam moved and Jason seconded to approve the Variance Request. Motion carried.

The Clerk reported that the next election cycle is beginning and training of poll workers has begun. An email has been sent to the person who had requested a large amount of election related material. The email notified him that the fee associated with his request would not be waived as requested, and once the required fee and a mailing address were received the request would be granted.

Invoices presented to the Clerk were approved for payment with a motion by Adam and second by Jason. Motion carried.

The next regular meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. on the 21<sup>st</sup> of September.

Adam moved and Jason seconded for adjournment and the chairman declared the meeting adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
